## Scripture Meditation

Methods and Explanations found in "Spiritual Disciplines for the Christian Life" by Donald S. Whitney

### What is it?

Scripture meditation is thinking on the truths and spiritual realities revealed in Scripture.

### What is it not?

Meditation is not us trying to empty our minds as some worldly meditation practices suggest. Nor is the goal to have some sort of visualization practice that alters reality. Our goal is to FILL our minds with truth. Scripture meditation will take brain work!

### Why should I do it?

Psalm 1:1-3

Blessed is the man  
    who walks not in the counsel of the wicked,  
nor stands in the way of sinners,  
    nor sits in the seat of scoffers;  
but his delight is in the law of the LORD,  
    and on his law he meditates day and night.

He is like a tree  
    planted by streams of water  
that yields its fruit in its season,  
    and its leaf does not wither  
In all that he does, he prospers.

Take notice of three things:

1. **"Blessed is the man....."** The word man here is singular. There is only one man. The word "blessed" though is plural. There are multiple blessings for this man. Why are there multiple blessings? Because...
2. **"...his delight is in the law of the LORD, and on his law he meditates day and night."** This man is blessed because he does not walk with the world, but instead he DELIGHTS in God's Word. What we delight in, we will meditate on. If we love something, we will think about it, and not just on church days, but each and every day.
3. The man who delights and meditates on God's Word, **"He is like a tree, planted by streams of water..."** A tree by a stream is one that grows. It PROSPERS! He will not wither and die when hard seasons come, but instead he will continue to grow and thrive.<sup>1</sup>

If we want to be like this man in Psalm 1, we must delight and meditate on God's word. Bible reading and hearing God's Word is valuable and necessary, but it is like short rainfall on hard ground - most of it runs off and only a little sinks in. However, meditation plants us directly on the water of God's Word and allows us to absorb it's truth, day and night. When hard times come, we will have absorbed God's Word and are prepared for the drought.

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<sup>1</sup> Note that prosperity and blessing here are not in reference to material things, i.e. money or worldly success. God may bless in this way, but what is in reference here is eternal, spiritual blessings. The greatest spiritual blessing is growing to be more Christlike, which is our sanctification.

## How do I do it?

### 1. Rewrite the Text in Your Own Words

Paraphrasing the text helps you to ensure you understand it's meaning. Find synonyms for the words used in the text and rewrite the text in your own words to help you to meditate on the truths of that scripture.

### 2. Look for Applications in the Text

When we meditate we should be looking at how to apply the text to our lives. We are not just hearers of the Word, but we want to be doers of the Word (James 1:22). Resolve to not walk away from the text until you know at least one thing God wants you to do with the verse in front of you.

### 3. Pray Through the Text

The Holy Spirit helps to guide our Christian lives and since the Holy Spirit inspired the very words of Scripture, it is a powerful thing to pray these words back to God.

#### EXAMPLE:

2 Corinthians 5:21 "For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God."

#### Rewrite

Out of God's care and love for us, he placed all of our wickedness on Christ. Christ is completely sinless, there is no wickedness or error in him. When I trust in Christ for my salvation, all my wickedness is taken by Christ at the cross and in exchange he gives me his goodness. I now stand before God on all of Christ's goodness.

#### Look for Applications

I am free from the burden of earning my righteousness - Jesus has already done it! Now I am free to love God, love others and pursue growing in Christlikeness without the pressure of trying to earn my salvation. When I fail and fall into sin, I must remember that I can repent and trust in the grace that God has already shown me. I can come to God in successes and failures, not because of my works, but because of what Jesus has done for me.

#### Pray

"Heavenly Father, you have given us the greatest grace through Jesus Christ. Jesus took all of my sin at the cross. All of my sin was placed upon him. Jesus is perfect, sinless and it was a great sacrifice and act of love that he would take my burden upon himself. Thank you for this grace! I am now able to stand before you God, not based on what I do, but what Jesus has already done for me. Please help me to remember this truth. Please help me to remember that when I sin, I can turn back to you God because Jesus has already paid the price for my sins. Help me not to run and hide from you in shame, but rather trust in the grace already given to me."

As a last word of encouragement, let me recommend that you take this one step further. After you have meditated on your verse, write it on a notecard or two or three. Carry it with you in your purse, put in on your bathroom mirror. We are called to meditate **day and night**. Give yourself the best opportunity to always have your mind in God's Word.
